## Times

Men's and Women's Doubles, 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM  
Mixed Doubles, 1:30 PM – 5:30 PM

Check-in starts one hour before the scheduled start time. Courts will be available for warm-up at least 30 minutes before the scheduled start time.

T-shirts, goody bags, and registration materials will be handed out at check-in.

## Skill Levels/Divisions

3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5+ - Skill levels may be combined depending on the number of players.

Go to <http://ipickleball.org/ifp-rating-descriptions/> for rating descriptions.

The tournament director reserves the right to reclassify player ratings.

## Format

Round robin pool play with most or all teams advancing to a single elimination bracket (there will be no consolation bracket). All matches will be one game to 15, win by 2. You will be guaranteed at least 4 matches during the tournament.

The tournament ball will be the Franklin X.

Prizes will be awarded to the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3<sup>rd</sup> place teams in each bracket.

## Entry Fee

Registration fee is \$30 for one event. A second event is an additional \$5. T-Shirts are optional and will cost an

additional \$10. Duluth Area Pickleball Association members receive a \$10 discount.

## Registration

Online registration only – Go to <http://gitchpb.com> and follow the registration instructions. An email will be sent to you confirming your registration information. Payment is made via PayPal.

Through July 14, only DAPA members are allowed to register. (One member of the team must be a DAPA member.) Registration is open to everyone starting July 15.

Registration deadline is September 29, 2019.

## Registration Limits

*Through August 31, 2019* – Until August 31<sup>st</sup>, limits will be placed on each division. Anyone that registers after the limit is reached will be put on a waitlist. (This is to give each division the opportunity to get enough teams to make it a good competition.)

Men's 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5+ – 8 teams in each division  
Women's 3.0, 3.5, 4.0+ – 8 teams in each division  
Mixed 3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5+ – 12 teams in each division

*Starting September 1, 2019* – If one or more divisions do not fill, the unfilled spots will be open to all, regardless of skill level.

Men's/Women's Doubles – 56 total teams  
Mixed Doubles – 48 total teams
