Skill Levels/Divisions

3.0, 3.5, 4.0, 4.5+ - Skill levels may be combined depending on the number of players.

The tournament director reserves the right to reclassify player ratings.

Format

Round robin pool play with most or all teams advancing to a single elimination bracket (there will be no consolation bracket). All matches will be one game to 15, win by 2. You will be guaranteed at least 4 matches during the tournament.

For small divisions, the tournament director reserves the right to change the format. You will still be guaranteed 4 matches.

The tournament ball will be the Onix Fuse Indoor.

Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place teams in each division.

Entry Fee

Registration fee is \$30 for one event. A second event is an additional \$10. Duluth Area Pickleball Association members receive a \$10 discount.

There will not be any t-shirts or "goodie" bags available for this event.

Boy Scout Troop 24 will be staffing the event, and part of the proceeds of the tournament will go to them as a thank you. When you register, you will have the option to give extra to them if you choose.
